## **1 Peter 4:8-10**

**"And above all things have fervent love for one another, for "love will cover a multitude of sins." Be hospitable to one another without grumbling. As each one has received a gift, minister it to one another, as good stewards of the manifold grace of God."**

It's important to note with Peter's suggestion to show fervent love to one another is immediately followed by two expressions of what that looks like. "Be hospitable to one another" and "As each one has received a gift, minister it." Peter didn't say wait until it is more convenient, but the opposite. What is immediately needed is a willingness to take what God has given us and share it feely and without apprehension - grace. Even if it is uncomfortable, but remember, it's meant to be a blessing for you and a huge benefit to someone else. The Lord will never give you a task that is too difficult. Brethren, give Jesus your "what-ifs" that rob you and others of the blessing when giving - grace. I know you will be totally amazed with the results.
