Psalms 9:9

The LORD is a refuge for the oppressed, a stronghold in times of trouble.

It is fascinating that in the Hebrew in both parts of the verse the word, מִשְׁגַּב, translated "misgab", (refuge or stronghold) is a high place, where their enemies can neither reach nor see them, according to commentaries and the lexicon.

Refuge and stronghold are used interchangeably in the first and second phrase in different translations.

Sometimes that is what we really need. The Word of God to come alive and breath on us the breath of Life. Our God is a refuge, a place where the world cannot see or get to you. We need to cuddle up in His arms, His high place, and know He is secure and comforting in the times when this world brings oppression.
